



Scope and Sequence

Grade

Book Level

Kindergarten

Beginner: Old and New Testament Overview

Focus: Student will learn the major characters and events of the Old and New Testament in a chronological format.

First Grade

Level 1 Old Testament Overview

Focus: Students will be introduced to the Old Testament timeline and with each lesson they will learn more about Old Testament characters and events.

Second Grade

Level 1 New Testament Overview

Focus: Students will be introduced to the New Testament timeline and with each lesson they will learn more about New Testament characters and events.

Third Grade

Level 2 Old Testament Overview

Focus: Students will be continue to learn more facts about the timeline and the characters and events of the Old Testament while memorizing the books of the Old Testament, the twelve sons of Jacob and the Ten Commandments.

Forth Grade

Level 2 New Testament Overview

Focus: Students will be continue to learn more facts about the timeline and the characters and events of the New Testament while memorizing the books of the New Testament, the twelve apostles and the Apostle's Creed.

Fifth Grade

Level 3 Old Testament Overview

Focus: Students will deepen their understanding of the Old Testament timeline, characters and events, while learning basic Old Testament geography.

Sixth Grade

Level 3 New Testament Overview

Focus: Students will deepen their understanding of the New Testament timeline, characters and events, while learning basic New Testament geography.

Middle School

Level 4 Old and New Testament Overview*

Focus: Students will master the Bible timeline and learn to use bible study tools including a concordance, Bible dictionary, topical Bible. (*Middle School students should begin with Level 3 if they have never done a Grapevine Studies overview.)

High School

Level 5 Old and New Testament Overview*

Focus: Students will incorporate Bible study tools and methods in order to take notes and answer critical thinking questions. Students will also choose hands-on projects and research topics with each lesson. (*High School students should begin with Level 4 if they have never done a Grapevine Studies overview.)

Grapevine Studies recommends that students go through different levels of the Old and New Testament studies at least twice before graduation.
