



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS LEVEL 5

What age does the Grapevine Studies Level 5 curriculum cover?

We have designed the Level 5 books for teens and adults. We recommend that students be at a high school academic level.

For what grade level was the Level 5 books designed?

High school or above.

Can I teach students younger than 15 years old?

Yes, if they have a desire to learn. We highly recommend trying a sample lesson on your student to determine their ability to use this book.

What supplies do I need to teach the Level 4 books?

Student Supply List: Bible, Grapevine Studies student book, colored pencils, a Bible Atlas, a Bible Concordance, a Bible Dictionary and a Topical Bible. (See our 3 Book set and the Atlas of the Bible Lands)

Since this level covers basic Bible study tools and work with an atlas, do I need these tools to do the lessons?

Yes, you can purchase books or there are many websites available with these tools, however we recommend the 3 book set and the Atlas of the Holy Land, available at the Grapevine Studies.

What makes this different from Levels 1 to 4?

Level 5 is a self-directed study, so no teacher manuals are needed. Our Level 5 course is designed for the student familiar with the Bible and who can spend 3-4 hours for each lesson.

Can I teach multiple ages with this curriculum?

No, only our Levels 1 to 4 are compatible.

What teacher manual do I need?

No teacher manual is needed.

What is the difference between Level 4 and Level 5?

Level 5 studies are self-directed and do not include stick figures. In Level 5, students use inductive Bible study skills, do hands-on projects and research topics related to each lesson. Level 5 books are designed for advanced students.
