



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Multi-Level

For what age is the Grapevine Studies Multi-Level curriculum designed?

We have designed the multi-level books for ages 7 and up.

For what grade level was the multi-level books designed?

Grades 2 and older.

Can I teach students younger than 7 years old?

Yes, if they have a desire to learn. We highly recommend trying a sample lesson on your student to determine their ability to use this book.

What supplies do I need to teach the multi-level books?

Student Supply List: Bible, Grapevine Studies student book, and colored pencils.

Teacher Supply List: Bible, Grapevine Studies Teacher book, dry erase board & markers (8 colors), and Bible dictionary.

Some of the multi-level books contain mapping exercises, do I need a Bible Atlas to teach the these studies?

No, all the maps you will need are contained within the student and teacher books.

However, if you would like to have an additional Bible atlas we recommend the *Student Bible Atlas* for elementary aged students and the *Atlas of the Holy Lands* for older students, both are available through Grapevine Studies.

Can I teach multiple ages with this curriculum?

Yes. For younger children you may want to simplify the stick figure drawings.

What teacher manual do I need?

Each study has a student manual and teacher manual.

May I make copies of Grapevine Studies book?

Yes, by purchasing the eBooks copies for your family, your class, or your group. By purchasing these eBooks your family, class, or group then has the legal right to make copies.

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My student does not read at grade level, will this prevent them from using this curriculum?

No, teachers or other students can read the written information to the student without hindering learning.



My student does not write at grade level, will this prevent them from using this curriculum?

No, most of the student work is drawing stick figures. Other writing activities can be completed verbally instead of in written form.

What is the difference between the color and black/white teacher editions?

The content is exactly the same. The color teacher's manual contains the stick figures and lesson notes in color instead of black and white. Teachers who are visual learners may prefer the color version.
