





Chronological


For those who prefer a chronological study of the entire Bible. we suggest starting with the Old Testament Overview and then moving to the New Testament Overview. We recommend placing your students at the age-appropriate level.

Seasonal

You can select a study that aligns with a specific season, like exploring the Birth of Jesus during the Christmas season or delving into The Resurrection or Moses and the Exodus as you approach springtime.

Interest

Another possibility is to opt for a study that caters to your specific interests or the interests of your student(s). Additionally, our topical studies serve as an excellent choice for your next Bible study.



For what denomination was Grapevine written?

Grapevine Studies focus on imparting Bible facts while leaving the interpretation of doctrine and application to the teacher. Currently, our curriculum is taught across a diverse range of denominations spanning six continents. If you have any specific questions, please refer to the Statement of Faith for Grapevine Studies or contact our office.

What version of the Bible do I use with Grapevine?

With Grapevine, you have the freedom to select the Bible version that you choose. However, we advise using a translations such as NASB, KJV, NKJV, ESV, among others. Paraphrases like Living, Message, or children's Bibles are not recommended.

Can I teach multiple ages/grades with these studies?

All our Topical Studies are designed for ages 7 and up, but by using the traceable student version of the study, you can include younger students in your lesson.

The Overview Studies have two levels. The PreK-K level is not compatible with the upper levels. The Early Elementary, Elementary, and Middle School levels are compatible and have one Master Teacher book. For younger students who want to follow along with older students, we recommend using the Early Elementary Traceable Student.

What is he Daily Schedule and Weekly Schedule?

- Daily Schedule: Is designed for homeschools or family devotions. It involves approximately
 one student page a day and takes about 15-20 minutes to teach per day.
- Weekly Schedule: Is designed for Sunday School or weekly Bible Study uses. It involves all
 the pages of the lesson and takes approximately 45-55 minutes to teach per week.




