

Creation (Part 1)

Memory Verse: Genesis 1:1


In the Beginning God

Read aloud: Genesis 1:1

Discuss In the Beginning God: God gave us this record of His work so that we would know that He is the Creator of all. This is "His Story," the history of the world. Let's start at the beginning. In the beginning who? God was there before anything was created, and He created all that is out of nothing.



Write and have students write: "God" or draw a purple triangle representing God.



Day 1

Read aloud: Genesis 1:1-5

Discuss Day 1: God established that Creation took place "in the beginning." God created by speaking the words, and what He spoke was created. On day one, God created light and defined day and night.

Draw and have students draw: Light and darkness.

Lesson Review:

- 1. When did God create? In the beginning.
- 2. How did God create? By speaking and it was so.
- 3. What did God do on the first day of the creation week? Light, night and day.
- 4. What did God do on the second day of the creation week? The waters above and below.
- 5. What did God do on the third day of the creation week? Dry land, and seas, plants, and trees.
- 6. What did you learn about Creation? God is the Creator of all things.


Memory Verse: Genesis 1:1


Day 2

Read aloud: Genesis 1:6-8

Discuss Day 2: On day two God created separated the waters, creating the sky.

Draw and have students draw: Waters above (clouds), and waters below (seas).






Day 3

Read aloud: Genesis 1:9-13


Discuss Day 3: God gathered the waters together, and called them "seas". He let the dry land appear, calling it "earth." God created an orderly world with plants and trees reproducing after their own kind.

Draw and have students draw: Land with a tree and the sea.
